- Vessels berthing at Inner harbor require to use vessel's own Gangway/Accommodation Ladder.
 Please have appropriate means of access ready for use on arrival.
- Valero Aruba Refinery does not accept slops without prior co-ordination. Contact vessel agent for details and contents.
- All vessel using reducers for loading/discharging or bunkering, should have these connected to their Manifold, prior to being "All Fast" at Berth.
- Vessels with bunker requirements must co-ordinate in advance between Valero Marine Sales.
- Valero Aruba Refinery Dress Code: All vessel's personnel wishing to visit Aruba, must be
 properly dressed with long pants and closed shoes when going ashore, and should carry with
 them a Photograph I.D./Passport or Seaman's Book. (Tank tops, Sleeveless shirts, Open Sandals,
 Slippers are not allowed.)

For Discharges: Complete set of consignee/receivers documents, to include load port Cargo inspectors reports, cargo analysis, OBQ and Ullage reports, bunker survey, VEF and Statement of Facts / Time Log etc.

For all vessels: Completed most recent Vessel Particulars Questionnaire (OCIMF). Ballast Water Reporting Form (IMO Res A 868 (20), TVE(USCG) or LOC which ever applicable.

Important Notice from Valero Aruba Refinery:

The Refinery premises are controlled and restricted areas. Trespassing or walking anywhere within the Refinery is not allowed and strictly forbidden, for all non refinery personnel, including but not limited to vessels crew. We sincerely advise you to use the Services offered by your Agent for you and your crew, to gain shore Liberty and access to the Refinery Main gate. Please be advised that it is forbidden to request or accept any form of transportation, other than that provided by your Agent to gain access to the Refinery Main Gate. In the event you or your crew fail to comply with this Refinery Regulation, a Fine of US Dollars 5,000.00 will be imposed upon your vessel, Owners or Operators.
